Facilitation of International Medical Doctors' Attachment Program at Sekou Toure Hospital

Background

Tanzania Royal Foundation is a non-governmental organization dedicated to supporting education, healthcare collaboration, youth development, and international partnerships. The Foundation aims to create opportunities for international exchange programs that strengthen medical education and cultural cooperation.

Through this initiative, Tanzania Royal Foundation plans to host medical students and healthcare trainees from USA who will undertake medical attachment programs at Sekou Toure Regional Referral Hospital, one of Tanzania's major regional referral and teaching hospital.

The Foundation will be responsible for managing and coordinating all academic and non-academic arrangements to ensure the visitors have a safe, comfortable, and productive stay throughout the attachment period.

Objectives

1. To facilitate the smooth arrival and settlement of visiting medical doctors.
2. To coordinate accommodation, meals, and daily transportation.
3. To provide reliable transport from accommodation area and Sekou Toure Hospital.
4. To organize tourism activities, including a visit to Serengeti National Park and saana national park.
5. To coordinate airport transfers upon arrival and departure.

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1. Airport Transfers

- Pick-up from the airport on arrival in Mwanza
- Drop-off to the airport after completion of the program.

2. Accommodation

- Arrangement of safe and comfortable accommodation during the attachment period.

3. Meals

- Provision of daily meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner).



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4. Local Transportation

- Daily transport from accommodation to Sekou Toure Hospital and back.

5. Tourism and Cultural Experience

- Organizing a tour to Serengeti National Park, including transportation, accommodation, meals, and park activities.

6. Coordination and Support

- General coordination, communication support, and local assistance during the entire stay.

Proposed Budget Estimate

Item	Estimated Cost (USD)
Airport pick-up (go and return)	200
Accommodation per person per day	100
Meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) per person	100
Daily transport to Sekou Toure Hospital per person per day	100
Coordination and administrative support (paid once)	50
Serengeti Tour Package per person (transport, 2 days accommodation and meals) Optional	1000
Local communication & emergency support (paid once)	50
Total Estimated Cost Per Person	1600 per person

- Successful completion of clinical attachment by visiting doctors.
- Strengthened international collaboration and cultural exchange.
- Positive exposure of Tanzania's healthcare and tourism sectors.
- Enhanced international networking opportunities for participating institutions.
